- Parkview Christian is located at 4400 No. 1st Street in Lincoln (or 1st and Superior Street). From Sterling you may want to take **Hwy 41 west to Hwy 77 (turn right) go north** until you get onto **Interstate 80 east** towards Omaha, **but** get off at the **I-180 Exit** (the exit right after the airport exit) and stay in the right lane because the **Superior Street exit** will be the very first exit (less than ¼ of a mile). **At the exit turn right** (or back west) and go to the **stop light (1st & Superior)** and **turn left** (or south). There are no lights on the field but it is located behind the school/church to the east. When you are heading to the stop light you can see the field off to the left if you were to look. Another choice of directions would be to take **Hwy 41 to Hwy 43 then to Hwy 2 to 84th Street, go north** until you get to **Havelock Street** (the stop light near the Lancaster event center) and **turn west**. You will continue on Havelock which will turn into **Superior Street** at Cornhusker Hwy. keep **heading west** (now on Superior St.) and you will **go past 27th and Superior heading west** until you reach **1st Street**. (you will have gone over I-180) then be looking for 1st Street and the light there to go south as shown above. If you should have any problems please contact Cheri Wirthele at 402-269-5137.
