By providing this literacy tool, we hope to increase fluency, vocabulary, and reading comprehension. Students who lack access to rich literature at home can fall behind academically.

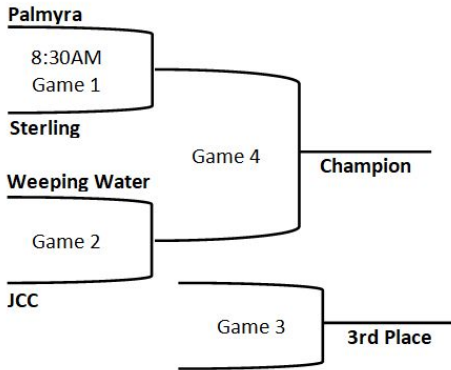

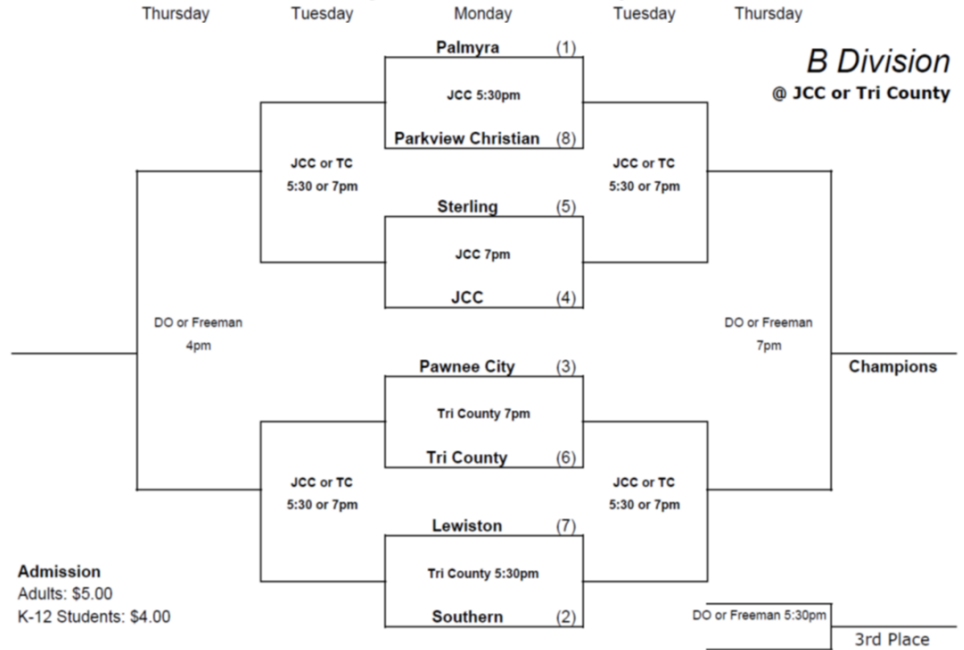
