Second Chance Breakfast a Success.

This year the students in grades 7-12 were given a second chance to eat breakfast after 1st period. A total of 2,616 more breakfasts were eaten this year compared to last school year. This is an increase of 76% and the result was an additional federal reimbursement of \$4,551.67 over last year! (There was also an increase of 2,925 lunches served over the last year.)
